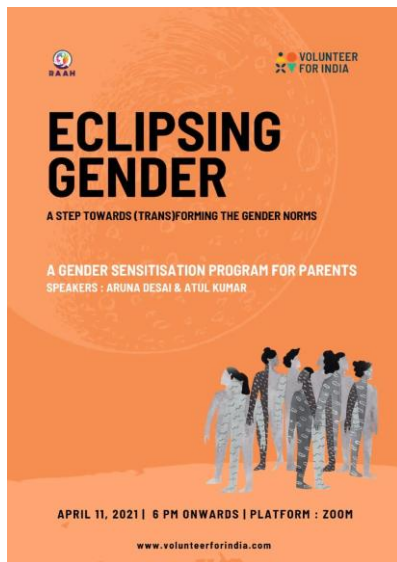

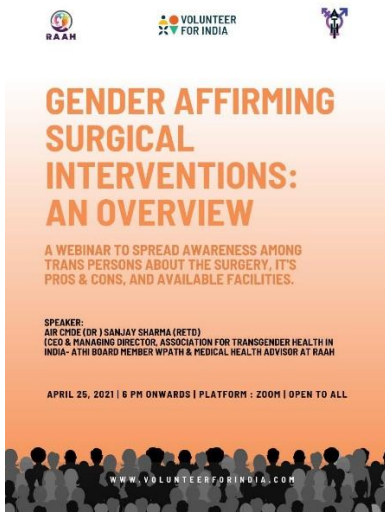

Gender Affirmative Surgeries An overview

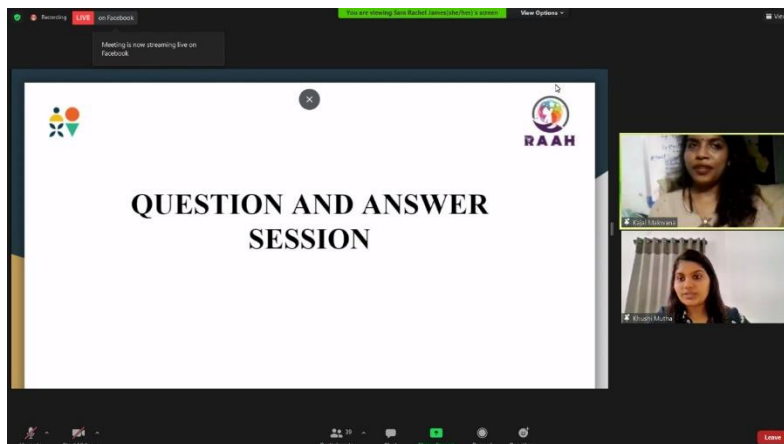
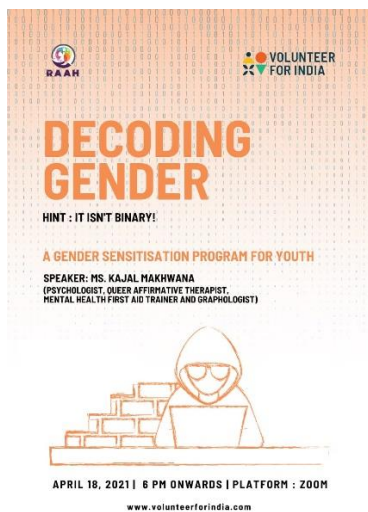
